UMPSA reaches out to 59 orphans and underprivileged children of Nur Iman for iftar

KUANTAN, 7 March 2026 – Universiti Malaysia Pahang Al-Sultan Abdullah (UMPSA) continues to strengthen the values of togetherness and social compassion through the organisation of a Corporate

Social Responsibility (CSR) Programme and a Friendly Gathering Ceremony with the Nur Iman Welfare Organisation for Orphans and the Underprivileged, Kampung Kempadang, here today.

“We want members of the university community not only to excel academically but also to be concerned about the welfare of those around them,” she added.

The programme began in the morning with a communal work session to prepare dishes for iftar, followed by STEM activities with the children.

She also expressed hope that programmes such as this would continue to be implemented in the future for the collective well-being of all.
