Universiti Malaysia Pahang Al-Sultan Abdullah (UMPSA) continues to strengthen its position as the best University Network (MTUN) through its outstanding achievement in the QS World University Rankings.

In the rankings announced today by Quacquarelli Symonds (QS), UMPSA was ranked 588th in the world.

The achievement also placed UMPSA eighth among public universities and 15th among higher education institutions.

The UMPSA Vice-Chancellor, Professor Ts. Dr. Yatimah Alias, said the achievement is a recognition of the university's commitment to the community, which has continuously strived to improve the quality of education, advance innovation, and create a sustainable future.
