Universiti Malaysia Pahang Al-Sultan Abdullah (UMPSA) was recognised by the world when it was ranked best in Asia in the QS Sustainability Ranking 2024 which assesses universities based on actions taken on (ESG) issues.

This rating is based on three main assessment scopes, namely Environmental Impact 45%, Social Impact 30%, and Governance 25% of the total score, which is based on 1,000 universities listed worldwide.

According to the UMPSA Vice-Chancellor, Professor Dato' Ts. Dr. Yuserrie Zainuddin, the university continues to work towards the achievement of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and assess the university's efforts in addressing ESG issues.
