A TVET graduate tracer study conducted in 2020 revealed that the Ministry of Rural and Cooperative Affairs produced the highest number of entrepreneurs, 44.6% of them earning incomes below RM1,000 per month, 76.7% from service workshops and 76.7% from tailoring and clothing manufacturing.
