## Speak Up! 2024 for Malaysian Heroes confidence booster

GAMBANG, 20 September 2024 – The 2024 *Speak Up*! event, now in its fifth edition, marked yet another successful collaboration between the Centre for Modern Languages (CML), Universiti Malaysia Pahang Al-Sultan Abdullah (UMPSA) and the Malaysian Armed Forces.

Held over two days, on 18 and 19 September, this year's program was specially designed to enhance the English communication skills of personnel from the 4th Brigade Headquarters (Mechanize), Kuantan Air Base, and Naval Region 1 Headquarters.
