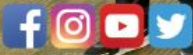

PEKAN, 3 March 2021 – Alongside the digital transformation of the Industrial Revolution (IR) 4.0 to produce holistic and expert graduates, Universiti Malaysia Pahang (UMP) has established a strategic partnership with its industry partner Abyres Enterprise Technologies Sdn.
