The QS ranking announced today saw Universiti Malaysia Pahang (UMP) being among the 62% best universities in the world in the QS World University Rankings 2021. According to the QS World University Rankings 2022, UMP is in the group of 801-1000, out of 1333 universities evaluated and recognised by the QS. The QS WUR 2022 rating evaluates a university based on 6 criteria, namely academic reputation, employer reputation, faculty student, citation per faculty, international faculty and international students. UMP's achievement in the citation per faculty criteria, where UMP is now ranked 560 best in the world while UMP is ranked 449 best in the world in the QS WUR 2022.

Ts. Dr. Farhan first woman appointed as technical panel member of the Professional Japan Association (MPJA)



The Halal Assurance and Halal Certification Management System has been recognised globally and has worldwide.

The development, evaluation and revision towards halal compliance and standard, fatwa, laws and regulations vital in helping Muslims in Malaysia and the world.

With wide expertise and experience in food technology and biotechnology, the Faculty of Chemical and Process Engineering Universiti Malaysia Pahang (UMP) lecturer, Ts. Dr. Farhan Mohd Said has been appointed as a technical panel member of the Professional Japan Association (MPJA), Japan and certified by the Department of Islamic Development of Japan.

She is also the first female technical panel member of fatwa to be appointed by the Japanese government.

MPJA is one of the pioneers of halal information resources in Japan, established to aid in and spread knowledge of the halal way of life to Japanese society.

MPJA also carries out halal auditing and certification that comply with international quality standards.

According to MPJA Managing Director Akmal Abu Hassan, the appointment of Ts. Dr. Farhan is right in line with the trend of halal certification, which is seen to start opening the eyes of entrepreneurs and industry players to the halal market.

In addition, Ts. Dr. also successfully became a halal auditor recognised by the Majelis Ulama Indonesia (MUI) in Indonesia.

In 2018, Ts. Dr. Farhan, together with a few MPJA auditors, conducted a Halal Audit monitoring visit in the facilities which are an enzyme drink processing plant, Dainichi Seiyaku Co. Ltd. in Gifu, a capital city in Central Japan (slaughterhouse), Zenkai Meat Corporation located in Hitoyoshi, Kumamoto, Japan.

According to Ts. Dr. Farhan, the programme ran smoothly, involving discussions and information exchange between auditors, companies and Fatwa representatives.

She, a JAKIM Halal trainer (TPH), is also invited to attend the online fatwa panel meeting held twice a month via Zoom amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

Among industries in Japan that applied for halal certification via MPJA are Ajishokuken Co. Ltd., Croda Chemical Co. Ltd., AminoUp Co. Ltd. and Nishiawa Beef Ltd.

MPJA is chaired by Akmal Abu Hassan who is a Malaysian citizen who lives in Japan. He hopes that the certification will open the world's eyes to the potential of the halal industry not only in Japan but in other countries.

A lecturer of the Faculty of Computing (FK), Universiti Malaysia Pahang (UMP), Associate Professor Ts. Dr. Mazlina Abd. Aziz, has received a special award for the Turkish Inventors and Innovators Network Award category through her research project, PISAH - COVID Patient Tracking System.

She did not expect the conversation with her colleagues on how to address the quarantine issue during the pandemic, which led to the idea of producing an app to help monitor the patients or close contacts who are undergoing home surveillance.

In fact, this research has also been considered a major contribution in addressing the Covid-19 pandemic.

Meanwhile, Dr. Diyana Kamarudin from the Faculty of Industrial Management (FPI) won a gold medal and special award in the Malaysia Association Award and Euro Business-Haller Award category for her research titled Hear Me Assistive Technology for the Deaf During Pandemic.

Another gold medal and special award were won by Ts. Dr. Norazaliza Mohd Jamil from the Centre for Creativity and Innovation in the Malaysian Association of Creativity and Innovation Award category for her research titled A GUI Simulator for the Deaf.

In addition, a silver medal was bagged by Ts. Dr. Roshahliza M Ramli from the Faculty of Electrical and Electronic Engineering with a research titled SMART Unmanned Ground Vehicle (UGV) for Covid-19 Waste Management.

The four UMP lecturers won special awards, three gold medals and one silver medal in the online Malaysia Association of Creativity and Innovation Award category for their research titled Hear Me Assistive Technology for the Deaf During Pandemic. The Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Research & Innovation), Professor Dr. Mohd. Idris bin Mohd. Salwana, congratulated the four UMP researchers who made the university proud.

“Despite the Covid-19 pandemic, it is not an obstacle for UMP lecturers to share research outcomes in the field of assistive technology through the research creation.

“I believe with this Covid-19 pandemic, researchers will be more likely to engage in research that can contribute to the society,” said Dr. Mohd. Idris.


