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UMP researchers develop SCAV self-driving bus for car



With various expertise in the engineering and technology field, researchers from Universiti Malaysia Pahang have developed a Smart Campus Autonomous Vehicle (SCAV) bus with a computer system to move on its own without a driver (self-driving).

The Smart Campus Autonomous Vehicle (SCAV) is equipped with various sensors and smart technology to navigate and move from one point to another by itself through the control of a computer system equipped with on-campus maps.

The Head of Programme (Mechatronics Engineering), Faculty of Manufacturing and Mechatronics Engineering, Universiti Malaysia Pahang, Muhammad Aizzat Zakaria, who specialises in self-driving car technology engineering (autonomous vehicle engineering), said the SCAV bus in Malaysia developed by internal experts.

“Currently, the development process is in the final stages with 80 per cent completion and is now focusing on refining the navigation technology in the bus itself.
