The ceremony was graced by the presence of the UMP Vice-Chancellor, Professor Dato' Ts. Dr. Yuserrie Zainuddin, Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Student Affairs and Alumni), Associate Professor Ts. The Eid festival was celebrated with various delicacies to be enjoyed by students and there was also an exhibition of activities by Ikatan Siswa Anak Darul Ta'azim (ISKANDAR) and Sekretariat Majlis Mahasiswa Anak-anak Pahang (Semampan).
