UMP climbs to 103 in the world in 2022 GWUR UI Ranking



Universiti Malaysia Pahang (UMP) is ranked 103 compared to 128 in 2021 in the 2022 UI Greenmetric World University Rankings. The evaluation is based on assessing environmental sustainability efforts involving six main scopes, namely waste, water, transportation and education which showed UMP achieved an overall mark of 8,200 compared to 7,800 in 2021, securing the fifth-best position in Malaysia and first in the Malaysian Technical University Network (MTUN).

Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) continues to lead as the best university in Malaysia when it is ranked 25th in the 2022 THE World University Rankings. Other universities in Malaysia are Universiti Malaya (UM) (50), Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) (53) and Universiti Tunku Abdul Rahman (UTAR) (60). The results of this rating were announced at Universitas Indonesia, Jakarta on 12 December 2022 in an online ceremony.

According to the UMP Vice-Chancellor, Professor Dato' Ts. Dr. Yusarie Zainuddin, this achievement is a testament to the university's commitment towards environmental conservation and preservation through various teaching, research, co-curricular activities and effective environmental management.
