200 UMP associates join Khatam al-Quran and World #QuranHour

KUANTAN, April 13, 2023 - A total of 150 Universiti Malaysia Pahang (UMP) staff and students participated in the Khatam al-Quran and World #QuranHour Ceremony in a programme that took place at the UMP Mosque, Gambang Campus.

The programme, which began at 8:30 am, was preceded by the Khatam al-Quran event led by UMP Islamic Affairs Officer Ustaz Md Abdu Sahak, who is also the Chairman of Rumah Ngaji Pahang.

The ceremony continued with the reflection (tadabbur) of the surah al-Insan delivered by the Islamic

Affairs Officer, Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM), Shah Alam, Ustaz Mohd Faizan Tajuid.

While the ceremony was officiated by the Director of the Institute of Civilisation and Strategic Studies (ITKAS), Associate Professor Dr. Hasan Ahmad.



In his speech, he called on UMP residents to intensify worship on the last 10 nights, which left only a few days.
