# **UMP ranked 201-250 best in THE Asia ranking**

PEKAN, 23 June 2023 - Universiti Malaysia Pahang (UMP) continues to excel when ranked 201-250 in the Times Higher Education Asia University Rankings 2023 (THE Asia) for the first time this year.

Assessments were made based on teaching and learning (25%), research (30%), citations (30%), internationalisation (7.5%) and industry (7.5%).

This success puts UMP in the ninth best position in Malaysia and first in the Malaysian Technical
