UMP organizes Pekan Bridge Run to promote a healthy lifestyle

PEKAN, 10 July 2023 - Universiti Malaysia Pahang (UMP) will be organizing the UMP Pekan Bridge Run for the first time on 2 September 2023 to promote a healthy lifestyle among UMP residents and

"In addition, participants also have the chance to win various lucky draw prizes, including electrical items and sports equipment," he said.



He further explained that with a registration fee of RM50 for the five-kilometre run and RM70 for the ten-kilometre run, participants will receive a T-shirt, medal, and e-certificate of participation.

He called upon high school students, higher education institutions (IPT) students, athletes, fitness enthusiasts, or anyone interested to join the programme and make it a lively event.

This programme is part of the university's branding activities and in conjunction with UMP's 21st Anniversary Celebration, supporting the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) agenda.
