El Nino is a weather phenomenon characterised by the warming of the Pacific Ocean near the equator. It can have significant impacts on weather patterns around the world, leading to increased precipitation in some areas and drought in others. The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) has predicted that a weak El Nino event will begin in late 2023, but it is difficult to say for certain what the exact impacts of this event will be or whether it will lead to record-breaking temperatures.
