Such was the lament of Amer Daniel Abd Rahman who is a Diploma in Computer Science graduand

from the Faculty of Computing.



He, who now works as an Information Technology Assistant at a company in Shah Alam said, it was like being given a second chance to live when he survived a road accident that almost claimed his life on the Guthrie Expressway.

According to him, the incident occurred at 1:00 a.m. when a vehicle exited the intersection suddenly, causing another car to lose control and rammed into his car.

"As a result of the collision, my car spun and overturned several times and suffered severe damage to all parts.

"However, I am very grateful as I only suffered minor injuries to the face, legs and hands.

"Alhamdulillah, today I was able to bring my parents to attend the UMPSA convocation ceremony," said Amer, who is the son of the Senior Manager, Institute of Postgraduate Studies (IPS), UMPSA.
