This award recognizes the continuous efforts and commitment of Local Authorities (PBT) and organizations in urban development.

The UMPSA Pekan Campus was honoured with the Zone Category Diamond recognition for achieving Greenhouse Gas emissions, equivalent to 4,705.16 tCO2.

Meanwhile, the UMPSA Gambang Campus received the Partner Category Diamond Recognition for reducing percent, equivalent to 2,465.52 tCO2.
