UMPSA organises Al Generation Festival 2025 (AlGenFest2025) to spark digital transformation through generative artificial intelligence

CYBERJAYA, 25 May 2025 – Universiti Malaysia Pahang Al-Sultan Abdullah (UMPSA), through the Centre of Excellence for Advanced Industrial Technology in collaboration with Gig Venture, successfully organised the Al Generation Festival (AlGenFest2025) on 24 and 25 May 2025 at Rekascape, Cyberjaya.

The two-day programme was officiated by UMPSA Vice-Chancellor, Professor Dr. Yatimah Alias.

The Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Research and Innovation), Professor Ts. Dr. Aida Mustapha, was also present as an invited panellist and guest of honour at the event.

The programme also supports the national policy on technology and innovation development, in line with the government's aspiration to make Malaysia a leader in digital technology in the region.
