The Times Higher Education (THE) World University Rankings 2026, announced on 9 October 2025, lists the world's best universities, also ranking it as the ninth-best university in Malaysia among both public and private universities.

UMPSA is the 16th public university established by the government to offer higher education programmes, as well as serving as the nation's Advanced (High-Level) TVET provider.
